

## General Terms and Conditions for the Use of the Website of the Association

### Bulgarian Medicines Verification Organisation

These General Terms and Conditions (the **Terms and Conditions**) govern the use of the website of the Bulgarian Medicines Verification Organisation, located at [www.bgmvo.org](http://www.bgmvo.org) (the **Website**).

In order to use the Website, each user must accept and agree to the Terms and Conditions.

#### I. Information about the Bulgarian Medicines Verification Organisation

This Website was created and is maintained by the Bulgarian Medicines Verification Organisation (BgMVO). BgMVO is a non-profit association for private benefit, with UIC 177021524 and registered office and head office in Sofia, 36 Dragan Tsankov Blvd., email: [office@bgmvo.org](mailto:office@bgmvo.org).

#### II. Purpose and Designation of the Website

1. The main purpose of this Website is to provide information for: the organisation and operations of the BgMVO and the work of the National Medicines Verification System (the **National System**) within the framework of the European Medicines Verification System (the **European System**), including the applicable regulations for its constitution. This information is publicly available.
2. The Website has a sub-section "**MAHs**" under the section "**Users of the system**" which is accessible only to holders of a marketing authorisation for a medicinal product valid in the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria's and representatives in the Republic of Bulgaria of the holders of marketing authorisations for medicinal products valid for the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria. These entities are given access to the "**MAHs**" sub-section of the Website after registration according to Section III below. This section provides to the marketing authorisation holders of a medicinal product valid for the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria and representatives in the Republic of Bulgaria of the holders of marketing authorisations for medicinal products valid for the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria information for their co-operation with BgMVO related to the functioning of the National System.
3. The Website contains free access sections for **Manufacturers, Parallel Importers, Wholesalers, Pharmacies** and **IT Providers**, a FAQ section and a News section.

#### III. Registration

1. Registration is required for access to the "**MAHs**" sub-section of the "**Users of the system**" section on the Website.
2. Access to the "**MAHs**" sub-section shall be granted to holders of a marketing authorisation for a medicinal product valid for the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria and representatives in the Republic of Bulgaria of holders of marketing authorisations for medicinal products valid for the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria. In order to register, they must enter the following data via this Website: name of the organisation, BULSTAT, name of the contact person (name, surname) and e-mail address.
3. The person's access shall be activated within 5 (five) working days of registration.

#### **IV. Trademarks and copyrights**

1. Trademarks posted on the Website are owned by BgMVO or its members, counterparties and partners respectively.
2. Copyrights and other intellectual property rights in the materials posted on the Website are property of BgMVO or third parties as indicated.

#### **V. Other**

1. BgMVO reserves the right to modify the Website and to supplement and amend the Terms and Conditions at any time when deemed necessary.
2. BgMVO does not guarantee the permanent and continuous functioning of the Website and the access to it. BgMVO is not liable for damages to property or to a user when using the Website when they are not a direct and immediate consequence of such use.
3. The Website may contain links to other websites, information sources and advertisements. BgMVO is not responsible for the content of such information sources.

Any disputes arising from the use of the Website shall be resolved by negotiation or, as a last resort, in the case of failure to reach an agreement, with the intervention of the competent authorities.
